



**Course Title:** GMP Cleanroom Cleaning (Basic)

**Course Location:** NSAI, Santry, Dublin 9, Ireland

**Course Content:**

The aim of this course is to give attendees the tools and knowledge they need in order to implement an effective cleaning program for a non-sterile GMP Cleanroom to EU GMP Grade C and Grade D. This Cleanroom Cleaning training course will provide essential information on the following:

- Introduction to the Cleanroom environment
- Behaviour in the Cleanroom setting
- Gowning procedures
- What to know before entering the Cleanroom
- Multiple surface cleaning & decontamination techniques
- Understanding the standard operating procedure (S.O.P.)
- Documentation practises and log book entries
- Aseptic Cleaning/Sanitisation
- Cleaning and Sanitisation skills demonstration & assessments
- Knowing why cleaning is important

**Course Overview:**

This course is accredited by ICEB with the designation Basic course. It is a one-day course. The course is suitable for:

- Any person in the organisation who is directly involved in cleaning of Cleanrooms/Hospitals
- Technicians who are responsible for aseptic processes and cleaning of equipment
- Personnel responsible for managing the Cleanroom/ Hospital environment
- Personnel who have responsibility for choosing cleaning products for use within the Cleanroom
- Personnel who work on investigation where a contributory factor is related to cleaning



### **Learning Outcomes:**

On successful completion of this training course, candidates should be able to:

- Identify what an effective cleaning SOP should entail
- Understand Cleanroom essentials (gowning, behaviour)
- Understand Cleanroom microbiology
- Recognise risk factors in a Cleanroom (contamination)
- Understand Cleanroom design and airflow
- Know the regulatory requirement surrounding Cleanroom cleaning
- Get a full understanding of aseptic processes
- Perform practical cleaning of surfaces within a Cleanroom
- Examine different cleaning systems available

### **Learning Assessment:**

As mentioned above, this course conforms to the ICEB accreditation framework. Each candidate will complete a 45-minute multiple choice question examination as part of the course assessment. The examination will consist of 25 questions and the pass mark is >20 correct answers. All candidates who pass will receive certification from ICEB.
